

Appointment Requirements:

- All truck visits will require an appointment be completed at www.mobilecontainerterminal.us/appointments prior to arrival for efficient processing at the terminal.
- An appointment can be created before a container is in a released status however you will not be allowed to pickup the container until updated as detailed knowledge of the appointment becomes available (i.e. container number, chassis number, and driver assigned)
- The specific driver must be input by dispatchers before the driver reaches the terminal or the driver will be routed to Driver Assistance.

Trucker Registration

Trucker Registration is required. All drivers must be registered to enter Mobile Container Terminal. Once registered, you will receive a Mobile Container Terminal I.D. Card. You will need this I.D. to enter our terminal. If you have not registered, you can do so by coming to our terminal office. We will register you for free the first time. If you lose your I.D. you will be charged to replace it.

Truck Driver Safety and Security Rules

- Unauthorized entry is a BREACH OF SECURITY and will result in suspended or revoked access.
- No Passengers or animals
- No talking on cell phones or radios while operating a moving vehicle
- No backing up in the In-gate or Out-gate lanes without the assistance of a Mobile Container Terminal employee.
- Maximum speed is 15 MPH in the yard. Wear your seatbelt. Comply with all Signage.
- Use Extreme Caution in the Chassis service area – 5 MPH – people working.
- Movement to the Dock is prohibited.

- Alcohol, illegal drugs and firearms or other dangerous weapons are prohibited.
- Use restrooms located at the longshoreman building.
- High visibility vests are required at all times while inside the terminals fence line. Vests are available for \$20 at our terminal security office.
