

## Coming To Mobile Container Terminal

Take route 1-10 to exit 25 (Virginia Street) and follow the detour signs to Mobile Container Terminal.

There are three inbound lanes off of Ezra Trice Blvd.

- Lane 1 ( left ) is a full service lane
- Lane 2 ( center ) is for bobtail vehicles only.
- Lane 3 ( right ) is for OOG (out of gauge) vehicles – this gate will be opened and closed remotely by our security guard.

Drivers will enter the terminal via Ezra Trice Blvd and proceed through the appropriate lane. Drive through Portal at 5-20 MPH. Speed range is important so the camera's in the Portal capture quality pictures of the container and the chassis.

Once the driver has exited the OCR portal the driver is instructed to proceed to either the driver's assistance kiosk or the inbound gate pedestals on a digital sign overhead as you drive through the lane. If there is any trouble with the transaction drivers will be routed to the driver assistance building. If you are sent to driver's assistance one of the following exist.

- Driver not registered.
- Trucking Company not registered.
- Equipment issues
- Booking issues
- Cargo release issues
- Appointment issues

If routed to Driver's Assistance the driver will need to identify his trouble ticket number by referencing the electronic display sign inside the kiosk

building. Next step will be to pick up a telephone inside the Driver's Assistance Building and assist in correcting the trouble.

If there are no problems with your transaction, digital signs will direct you to the ingate lanes in order to complete the gate process.

- Lanes 1 & 2 are for empty containers
- Lanes 3, 4, 5 and 6 are for full service moves (export loads, dry, hazardous, and reefers).
- Lanes 7 & 8 are for bobtails
- Lane 9 is for OOG loads.

Once you enter your lane, swipe your MCT I.D. on the pedestal. If no assistance is needed your routing ticket will print giving you instructions to complete your visit. In some circumstances assistance will be required and a clerk will help you complete the transaction.

If you have an empty container, after you swipe your card you will be given instructions on the kiosk display to open both rear doors of the container for inspection. After visual inspection has been completed the clerk will instruct you to close the doors with audio speakers mounted on the camera bridge to the rear.

Once you have completed your transaction in the yard and are ready to leave the terminal, you drive through the outbound OCR/LPR portal to the outgate. Once the driver reaches the outgate swipe your MCT I.D. card. If everything is ok, an EIR prints. If there is an exception then a clerk will intervene and assist you with the completion of your transaction. If you are exiting bobtail then proceed to the bobtail lane to complete your move.
